BIHAR PROJECTS WHAT'S HAPPENING ON THE GROUND.

A. Restoring Sight, Building Women's Careers

Over 600+ eye-surgeries everyday | Village camps identify cataract cases and help people reach surgery with transport, counselling, medicines and follow-ups. Alongside clinical care, young women train as optometrists with residential support and job placement, creating skilled local work and stronger eye-care systems.

B. Strengthening TB Care Systems

55,000+ people reached through community TB care | Doorstep screening and sample collection connect patients quickly to labs, and access to treatment. Clinics receive hands-on training and simple trackers so teams can act on missed doses and late follow-ups, raising completion rates and protecting families.

C. Bridging Opportunity Gaps in Education

2,500 youth directly engaged each year | First-generation adolescents join a fellowship program that blends study support with leadership, constitutional values, digital skills and career navigation.

D. From Survivor to Advocate

At the heart of Trafficking and sexual crimes | In these blocks, community learning centres work on a Preventive and Restoration model - using education, theatre, art and dialogue to teach rights and build voice for the future; rebuild income, agency, and public participation through steady mentorship and market-linked livelihood.

E. Youth Upskilling for New-Economy Jobs

2,000+ youth trained; 5,00,000 reached | Local youth are mobilised into in-house, industry-aligned courses in programming, hospitality and primary healthcare etc, alongside communication, problem solving and digital fluency.
